If these matching records are not found, the type 13 record will be rejected.

Acreage will not be accepted by DAS more than 60 days prior to the earliest final planting date for the crop/type in the county. This does not apply to California Sugar Beets (except counties 025, 035, 049, 089 & 093). This does not apply to Wheat and Barley in Idaho, Oregon and Washington.
