Question	Answer
<p>In 2011, what is the new P48 Record Type Delete record?</p>	<p>The 2011 Record Type Delete, "P48" record is for deleting all accepted records of a specific record type for an AIP. The purpose of this record is to maintain the current functionality that allows deletion of all Agency/Company Employee Data, "T54", Agent Data, "T55", Loss Adjuster Data, "T56", Conflict of Interest, "T51", Quality Control Reporting, "T57" and Notice of Loss, "T58" records.</p>
<p>What exactly can be deleted using the new P48 Record Type Delete record?</p>	<p>The P48 record will be used for deleting all accepted records for the following record types:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> P51 – Conflict of Interest P54 – Employee P55 – Agent P56 – Adjuster P57 – Quality Control Reporting P58 – Notice of Loss
<p>How will the P48 Record Type Delete record work in 2011?</p>	<p>For 2011, the Record Type Delete, "P48" may be submitted in a batch along with any other AIP submissions or by itself. When received, it will delete all records of the type specified in the P48 record "Delete Record Type Code" field for that AIP. Once deleted the deleted record types must be re-submitted to maintain or process policies in the ITM system. There is no limit to the number of times that an AIP is allowed to submit and delete these record types.</p>
<p>Why is there a separate P48 Record Type Delete record for deleting entire groups of files?</p>	<p>The addition of the Record Type Delete, "P48" record was necessary because the existing Policy Delete, "P49" record deletes policy and not records containing supporting data.</p> <p>For 2011 PASS needed to supply the delete functionality currently available in DAS where submission of these record types removes all previously submitted records of that type. The Record Type Delete Record, "P48" is designed to provide that functionality.</p>
<p>What happens when the records are deleted?</p>	<p>Once deleted the record type data is no longer available for future submission. And deleted Agent information is unavailable in the Directory Listing when deleted using a "P48" record. RMA historical reporting record types must be re-submitted to be re-activated.</p>
