SUBJECT: Large Claim Notices for Processing Pumpkins in Illinois, Indiana,
and Ohio

BACKGROUND:

Section II.A.13. of the Standard Reinsurance Agreement states:

“As a condition of reinsurance, prior to commencing any loss adjustment activities the Company must notify FCIC upon receiving notice of a potential claim on an eligible crop insurance contract, which is likely to exceed \$500,000, or such other amount as determined by FCIC.”

ACTION:

As of the date of this Informational Memorandum, all Approved Insurance Providers (AIPs) servicing Illinois, Indiana, and Ohio will be required to provide a Large Claim Notice to the Springfield Regional Office for all notices of loss received for eligible Processing Pumpkin crop insurance contracts regardless of the amount of anticipated indemnity.
