	The Springfield Regional Office (RO) recently received a number of requests f Approved Insurance Providers (AIP) to further extend the timeline for submitti	

Paragraph 1540 of the 2015 FCIC 18010 Crop Insurance Handbook (CIH) authorizes the ROs to extend the deadline up to, but not more than 60 days after the production reporting date. Since the extreme adverse weather conditions have created an inability for AIPs to complete and submit PAIRs for RO Determined Yields by the extended deadline, AIPs are authorized an additional 30 calendar days from March 16, 2015, to April 15, 2015, to complete and submit PAIRs accompanying RO Determined Yield requests.

Acceptance Inspection Reports (PAIRs). Due to continued inclement weather and high

volume of policies requiring a PAIR, the extension requests are approved.

Supporting records/documentation initially received after the applicable date specified above will not be accepted, unless the RO Determined Yield request results in a lower APH yield in accordance with the 'Exception' noted in Paragraph 1540 [see also, Paragraph 2002 A. (3) (c)] of the CIH.
