SUBJECT: Citrus Loss Adjustment Procedures for Freeze Damage in California -  
Expanded Authorization into Additional Counties

**BACKGROUND:**

On January 22, 2007, the Risk Management Agency (RMA) issued Manager's Bulletin MGR-07-003 that clarified loss adjustment procedures and authorized the use of determinations of freeze damage made by packers for the 2007 crop year citrus losses in only the California counties of Kern, Fresno, Madera, and Tulare. RMA has learned that other counties were affected by the freeze to the same or similar extent as the four referenced counties. The purpose of this bulletin is to apply the authorization provided in MGR-07-003 to additional California counties.

**ACTION:**

This authorizes the use of determinations of freeze damage made by packers as directed in MGR-07-003 for 2007 crop year citrus losses in all California counties, applicable for all eligible crop insurance contracts insured under the 2007 AZ-CA Citrus Crop Provisions (00-126) and the 2007 Pilot California Citrus Dollar Crop Provisions (2002-0215).

**Disposal:**

This bulletin is effective for the 2007 crop year only.
