with the Acreage Crop Reporting Streamlining Initiative (ACRSI)

BACKGROUND:

As part of the Acreage Crop Reporting Streamlining Initiative (ACRSI), an ACRSI subteam was tasked with reviewing the acreage reporting dates (ARDs) across both Risk Management Agency and the Farm Service Agency programs. As a result of this review, some ARDs for certain county/crop programs (listed in the attachments) will be the same date as the final planting date (FPD), or will be within five days following the FPD.

RMA understands some policyholders may not have adequate time to submit their acreage reports if the insured crop's ARD is the same as or closely follows the FPD.

ACTION:

Approved Insurance Providers (AIPs) may permit policyholders to file acreage reports no later than five days after the ARD for the county/crop programs listed in the attachments, when the insured crop is planted on or within five days prior to the FPD.

The affected county/crop programs with contract change dates of November 30 and December 31 for the 2012 crop year are listed in Attachments 1 and 2, respectively, and the affected county/crop programs with a contract change date of April 30 for the 2013 crop year are listed in Attachment 3. RMA will update this bulletin with subsequent attachments to include other affected county/crop programs for the 2013 crop year once the actuarial material is filed.
