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**SUBJECT:** 2015 Spring County Crop Program Deletions

**BACKGROUND:**

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors approved the deletion of a number of county crop programs for the 2015 and succeeding crop years. The following attachment, 2015 Crop Year County Spring Crops Program Deletions, lists the deletions by commodity, state, and county for permanently-established (non-pilot) programs. These county crop programs were recommended and approved for deletion due to the fact that no participation by any producers has occurred within the last five years.

**ACTION:**

These county crop insurance programs are being terminated effective for the 2015 and subsequent crop years. Even though there has been no participation in these county crop programs Approved Insurance Providers (AIP) are encouraged to monitor their book of business because if an AIP accepts an application or fails to timely cancel a crop insurance policy for the 2015 crop year by the cancellation date, no reinsurance will be provided.
