Actual Production History Pilot Plan of Insurance -Sesame Policy and Insurance

BACKGROUND:

In November of 2009, the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) Board of Directors (Board) approved implementation of an Actual Production History Sesame Pilot Program (APH-Sesame) beginning with crop year 2011.

The APH-Sesame pilot program is offered in 29 counties in Texas and Oklahoma. The pilot program will cover clean dry sesame with white and black sesame being the insurable types offered under the APH-Sesame pilot program.
