2010 Crop Year Group Risk Plan Payment Yields and Group Risk Income

Protection Plan Final County Yields and County Revenues for Corn, Grain

Sorghum, and Soybeans

In accordance with Section 3 of the Group Risk Plan (GRP) Crop Provisions, payment yields have been approved for corn, grain sorghum, and soybeans for the 2010 crop year. These payment yields have been incorporated into the Actuarial Data Master (ADM) and will be available by close of business today on the Risk Management Agency (RMA) website at: www.rma.usda.gov/data/grpfinal/.

In accordance with Section 3 of the Group Risk Income Protection (GRIP) Plan Crop Provisions, final county yields and county revenues have been approved for corn, grain sorghum, and soybeans for the 2010 crop year. These final county yields and county revenues have been incorporated into the ADM and will be available by close of business today on the RMA website at: www.rma.usda.gov/data/gripfinal/.

In some situations, the National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) has been unable to provide a county estimate for the basis of the GRP or GRIP offer available in that specific county.

GRP provisions for the 2010 crop year state:

If NASS is unable to provide a yield used to determine the payment yield on the same basis as the expected county yield described in the actuarial documents, RMA will determine the payment yield.

GRIP provisions for the 2010 crop year state:

If NASS is unable to provide a yield used to determine the final county yield on the same basis as the expected county yield described in the actuarial documents, RMA will determine the final county yield.
