	SUBJECT:	Pasture, Rangeland, Forage (PRF) and Apiculture (API) Pilot Programs –Acreage Report Date (ARD) and Sales Closing Date (SCD) Requirements

BACKGROUND:

The 2010 Rainfall Index (RI) and Vegetation Index (VI) Basic Provisions and PRF and API Crop Provisions changed the SCD and ARD from November 30 to a September 30 SCD and a November 15 ARD. The Risk Management Agency (RMA) has received requests to clarify what data is required by each of the new dates. Since the sales closing and acreage reporting dates were previously the same date, this change generated questions and requests for clarification concerning what information is required at SCD and ARD.

ACTION:

In addition to those elements required on an application, the following data is required on or before the SCD:

- County
- Crop
- Coverage Level
- Protection Factor

In accordance with Section 8 of the RI and VI Basic Provisions data required on the acreage report on or before the ARD includes, but is not limited to:

- Insurable acres by county
- Insured acres by Grid ID
- Share
- Practice (Index Intervals)
- Crop Type
- Grid ID, including the FSA Farm, Tract and Field Number(s)
- Certification of Point of Reference
