SUBJECT: Texas Citrus Tree Plan of Insurance

BACKGROUND:

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors (FCIC Board) approved the Texas Citrus Tree plan of insurance on May 19, 2011. Texas Citrus Mutual submitted this plan of insurance to the FCIC Board under Section 508(h) of the Federal Crop Insurance Act. It is a tree based dollar amount of insurance program and will cover grapefruit, orange and tangerine trees in Cameron, Hidalgo and Willacy counties, Texas.
