SUBJECT: Actual Production History (APH) Camelina Pilot Program

**BACKGROUND:**

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors (FCIC Board) approved the APH Camelina Pilot crop insurance program on September 22, 2011. The program was submitted and approved under section 508(h) of the Federal Crop Insurance Act. Beginning with the 2012 crop year, insurance coverage will be available to camelina growers in 41 counties in Montana and 11 in North Dakota.
