	SUBJECT:	Notice of Intent to Research the Feasibility and Development of an
		Insurance Program for Pomegranates

BACKGROUND:

The Federal Crop Insurance Act (7 U.S.C. 1522(c)(1)(C) requires the Risk Management Agency (RMA) enter into contracts to carry out research and development.

The Act (7 U.S.C. 1522(c)(2)(B)) also requires that RMA consult with groups representing producers of agricultural commodities that would be served by the policies that are the subject of research and development efforts. RMA is planning to pursue research into the feasibility of insuring pomegranates. We are expanding that scope to anyone such as packers or processors who may be interested in the pomegranate industry.

ACTION:

RMA plans to solicit a contract for determining the feasibility of developing a crop insurance product for pomegranates. We seek any preparatory input from interested parties about the level of interest from producers, or the pomegranate industry about the availability of private insurance products that may be available covering pomegranates, or any other relevant issues that should be considered when carrying out the feasibility and research for potential program development. Any information pertaining to market impacts, type of insurance most suitable for the crop, or impact on crop expansion would be beneficial.
