Notice of Intent for Research and Development of an

Insurance Program for Hybrid Sweet Corn Seed

BACKGROUND:

The Federal Crop Insurance Act (7 U.S.C. 1522(c)(1)(C) requires the Risk Management Agency (RMA) enter into contracts to carry out new crop research and development. RMA is considering research and development for an insurance program to cover hybrid sweet corn seed.

The Act (7 U.S.C. 1522(c)(2)(B)) also requires that RMA consult with groups representing producers of the agricultural commodity that the subject policy would serve. We are expanding that scope to any person(s) who may be interested in the hybrid sweet corn seed industry.

ACTION:

RMA is considering solicitation of a contract for development of a crop insurance product to cover hybrid sweet corn seed. We seek any preparatory input from parties about producers' level of interest, or from the hybrid sweet corn industry about the availability of private insurance products for hybrid sweet corn seed, or any other relevant issues one would consider when carrying out the feasibility and research for potential program development. Any information pertaining to market impacts, type of insurance most suitable for crop, or impact on crop expansion would be beneficial.
