SUBJECT: Hawaii Tropical Fruit & Hawaii Tropical Tree Pilot Program Materials for

the 2007 and Succeeding Crop Years

BACKGROUND:

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) contracted for the development of the Hawaii Tropical Fruit and Hawaii Tropical Tree Pilot Programs. The FCIC Board of Directors approved the pilots in September, 2005 contingent upon resolving issues raised by the expert reviews. The rating and pricing issues brought forth by the expert reviews have been resolved and the pilots are ready for implementation. The Hawaii Tropical Fruit Pilot is an Actual Production History plan of insurance. The Hawaii Tropical Tree Pilot is a Dollar Tree plan of insurance. The pilots will be available for bananas, coffee, and papayas in Hawaii, Honolulu, Kauai, and Maui Counties in Hawaii.

ACTION:

The RMA has placed the Hawaii Tropical Fruit Crop Provisions (07-0255), Hawaii Tropical Tree Crop Provisions (07-0265), Comprehensive Tree Value Endorsement (07-0265A), Hawaii Tropical Fruit Underwriting Guide (24200), Hawaii Tropical Tree Underwriting Guide (24210) and Training Manuals on the Risk Management Agency Website at:
