**SUBJECT:** 2009 Crop Year Additional Price Elections for Multiple Actual Production History (APH) Crops: Barley for Counties with a Sales Closing Date prior to March 15, Potatoes (Florida; specified types), Wheat, and the Additional Value Price for APH Malting Barley for select Winter Planted Barley Counties

The Risk Management Agency is providing APH additional price elections for multiple crops for the 2009 Crop Year as follows:

2009 Crop Year Additional Price Elections for Multiple Actual Production History (APH) Crops: Barley for Counties with a Sales Closing Date prior to March 15, Potatoes (Florida; specified types), Wheat, and the Additional Value Price for APH Malting Barley for select Winter Planted Barley Counties

The additional price elections represent the maximum price elections for the indicated states, counties, types, crop year and specified sales closing dates, and are available to producers who insure their 2009 crops at levels above catastrophic coverage. Price election choices must be made on or before the sales closing date.

\*An additional price election may be announced for wheat in counties with a March 15 sales closing date, no later than 15 days prior to this date.

**Malting Barley:**

In accordance with the APH Small Grains Crop Insurance Malting Barley Price and Quality Endorsement, the 2009 CY additional value price under Option A is \$1.25 for winter seeded malting barley in the Idaho counties of Cassia, Nez Perce, and Payette.
