

The full population of organic crops and policies are represented in this dataset. However, corresponding conventional data is only provided when the year/crop/county has organic acreage insured for a comparison. The comparison report begins with crop year data from 2004 and is shown by crop year, State and by crop. This report will be updated by RMA twice a year. The spring update will provide a picture of the losses from the previous crop year and the fall update will include an updated policy count from the current crop year.
