November 20 Sales Closing Date Near For Crop Insurance in South Carolina

VALDOSTA, Ga., Nov. 6, 2013 — The United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Risk Management Agency (RMA) reminds farmers of the **November 20** sales closing date for crop insurance. This sales closing date applies to crop insurance policies for apples in Greenville, Oconee, Pickens and Spartanburg counties; blueberries in Horry County and peaches in Aiken, Allendale, Anderson, Calhoun, Cherokee, Chesterfield, Edgefield, Greenville, Lexington, Marlboro, Orangeburg, Saluda, Spartanburg and York counties. The sales closing date is the last day to buy a new policy or change an existing policy's coverage level.

Crop insurance is sold and delivered solely through private crop insurance agents. Contact a local crop insurance agent for more information about the program. A list of crop insurance agents is available at all USDA Service Centers and on the RMA website at www.rma.usda.gov/tools/agents/.
