## November 20 Sales Closing Date Near for Crop Insurance in South Carolina

VALDOSTA, Ga., Nov 6, 2014 — USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) reminds farmers of the November 20 sales closing date for crop insurance in South Carolina. This sales closing date applies to crop insurance policies for apples in Greenville, Oconee, Pickens and Spartanburg counties; blueberries in Horry County; and peaches in Aiken, Allendale, Anderson, Calhoun, Cherokee, Chesterfield, Edgefield, Greenville, Lexington, Marlboro, Orangeburg, Saluda, Spartanburg and York counties. The sales closing date is the last day to buy a new policy or change an existing policy's coverage level.
