## February 28 Sales Closing Date Near For Crop Insurance in South Carolina

VALDOSTA, Ga., Feb. 11, 2014 — The USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) reminds farmers of the **February 28** sales closing date for crop insurance in South Carolina. This sales closing date applies to crop insurance policies for corn, cotton, grain sorghum, peanuts, and soybeans. Also included is flue-cured tobacco in Chesterfield, Clarendon, Colleton, Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Georgetown, Horry, Lee, Marion, Marlboro, Sumter, and Williamsburg counties. The sales closing date is the last day to buy a new policy or change an existing policy's coverage level.

Crop insurance is sold and delivered solely through private crop insurance agents. Contact a local crop insurance agent for more information about the program.
