RMA Spring Acreage Reporting Date

SPRINGFIELD, Ill. June 28, 2012 - Brian D. Frieden, Director of the Risk Management Agency's Springfield Regional Office, reminds producers to report 2012 spring crop acreage to their insurance agent by July 15.

Michigan crops include: spring barley, spring cabbage, corn (for grain and for silage), dry beans, forage seeding, green peas, hybrid corn seed, spring oats, popcorn, potatoes, soybeans, sugar beets and tomatoes.

With the severe weather conditions this year, producers are also encouraged to contact their crop insurance agent if they have concerns about a crop loss.
