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Spring Crop Projected Prices Announced

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., February 13, 2013 — On March 1, the Risk Management Agency released their projected prices for spring crops. These prices are based on the Chicago Board of Trade and apply to both revenue and yield protection insurance plans.

<u>Crop</u>	<u>Price</u>
Corn	\$5.65
Corn (organic certified)	\$8.79
Soybeans	\$12.87
Soybeans (organic certified)	\$19.81
Hybrid Seed Corn	\$5.65
Grain Sorghum	\$5.53

The Risk Management Agency is the part of the United States Department of Agriculture that administers the federal crop insurance program. Private insurance companies, approved by the Risk Management Agency, sell and service the policies. These companies have crop insurance agents who work with producers directly.
