STATEMENTS: The statement referencing breached levees due to the 1993 flood has been removed from the SPOIs in all counties where it appeared. A new statement referencing the applicable high-risk rates for land affected by breached levees has been added to SPOIs for Corn, Grain Sorghum, Oats, Popcorn, and Soybeans in **Carroll, Clay, Holt, and Ray** Counties.

A high-risk land statement was added to the Corn, Grain Sorghum, and Soybean FCI-35s in **Benton** County.

High-risk land statements were removed from the SPOIs for Corn, Grain Sorghum, and Soybeans in **Hickory** County. High-risk land statements were also removed from Hybrid Corn Seed SPOIs and FCI-35s in **New Madrid, Scott, and Stoddard** Counties.

Quality Discount Tables have been updated for Oats.

The Corp of Engineers Easement (CEE) rating statements were removed from the map rules pages of the counties surrounding Lake Harry S. Truman. All land surrounding this lake will be classified on the High-Risk Maps for the respective counties.

OTHER: The hail exclusion factors have been revised for all crops.

Changes were made in the premium subsidy factors for the GRIP plans of insurance.
