STATEMENTS: For **Dry Beans** in Crowley and Pueblo Counties – statement removed that read, "Acreage of the designated crop/type/practice not located in the specified FCI-33 Map Area and/or Transitional Yield Locator Map area shall have the yield/yield factor shown on the Transitional Yield Table." For Dry Beans in all counties, - statement removed that read, "Other type or classes of Beans will be insurable only by written agreement." The High Risk area statement has been modified for **all crops** in all counties with a high risk map to reflect changes to ITM. The organic farming practice and organic rate factor statements have been removed from all crops in all counties. The organic APH (database) statement has been modified for all crops in all counties as new practices have been created for organics. For **Onions**, the settlement of claim statement has been shortened, but the percent of damage referenced in Section 13(d) of the onion crop provisions continues to be 40 percent. The Oats date statement in Elbert County has been deleted. For Potatoes in Alamosa, Conejos, Costilla, Rio Grande, and Saguache – statement removed that read. "Potato acreage is insured under the basic coverage excluding options." For Soybeans and Corn, a new organic price statement has been added. For Sunflowers in Baca, Kiowa, and Prowers County - statement removed that read, "Classification 001 is applicable to all irrigated producers." For Corn, there are two statements that have been removed. The first deals with the settlement of claim statement dealing with acreage that you intend to harvest in a manner other than you reported it for coverage. The second deals with the insured crop statement that allows for insurance on high-oil blends and commercial varieties of high-protein hybrids without a written agreement. The last paragraph of the skip-row **Corn** statement has been modified. The language regarding the 75 percent planting population has been replaced with, "In addition, skip row corn must be seeded at a rate to produce at least the yield used to determine the production guarantee." New falling number discount table located in the Quality Statement for Wheat. Quality Factors have been updated.

PRACTICES/TYPES: Organic (certified) and Organic (transitional) are new practices for all 11/30 crops.

MAPS: Refer to attached Summary of Change Log. A new Final Plant Date map for Oats was created for Elbert County. The date map replaces the date statement that had been on the **Elbert County** Special Provisions.

TRANSITIONAL YIELDS: Transitional Yields were reviewed for Barley.

REFERENCE RATES AND YIELDS: Reference Rates and Yields were reviewed for **Barley** in **Adams**, **Alamosa**, **Arapahoe**, **Boulder**, **Conejos**, **Costilla**, **Delta**, **Jefferson**, **La Plata**, **Larimer**, **Logan**, **Mesa**, **Moffat**, **Montezuma**, **Montrose**, **Morgan**, **Phillips**, **Rio Blanco**, **Rio Grande**, **Routt**, **Saguache**, **Sedgwick**, **Washington**, **Weld**, **and Yuma Counties**.

OTHER: Biotech Endorsement (BE) for **Corn** – the option rates for BE are now found on the rates tab under the Optional Coverage Rate(s) heading. Coverage level for **Sunflowers** now includes the 80-85 percent.
