DELETIONS: **AGR-Lite** deleted from Broomfield County.

STATEMENTS: A new statement for Adjusted Gross Revenue-Lite (AGR-Lite) has been added to the Special Provisions and reads, "In accordance with section 27(a), the statute authorizing the Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) states that if the producer is eligible to receive benefits under NAP and from any other USDA program for the same loss, the producer: (1) cannot receive benefits from both programs; and (2) must elect which benefit they wish to receive." The rate map statement for Apples and Peaches has been modified to reflect changes to ITM. The organic farming practice and organic rate factor statements have been removed for Apples, Grapes, and Peaches. The organic APH (database) statement has been modified for all crops in all counties as new practices have been created for organics. For Grapes, the statement that classified producers as having a classification of 001 has been removed.

PRACTICES/TYPES: Organic (certified) and Organic (transitional) are new practices for **Apples**, **Grapes**, and **Peaches**.

TRANSITIONAL YIELDS: No changes.

REFERENCE RATES AND YIELDS: No changes.
