To determine the correct Contract Price for Green Peas, the verifier must have a copy of the Processor Contract for the crop year for which the records have been provided. The tenderometer reading or sieve size used to determine the contract price needed to calculate pounds adjusted for quality is:

Early Season: 115 Tenderometer Reading or #3

Sieve Size

Mid Season: 110 Tenderometer Reading or #4

Sieve Size

Late Season: 110 Tenderometer Reading or #4

Sieve Size

If the variety being grown by the insured does not appear on this list, agents should contact their insurance company, and the insurance company will contact the RMA St. Paul Regional Office at 651-290-3304. Please do not contact the processor directly. When calling the Regional Office, please provide the name and location of the processor who is contracting the variety in question.

This may be the last year we will publish the variety list. The types of green peas will remain defined as they currently are on the actuarial documents. In the future, insureds would need to provide the necessary information on the variety(s) being grown so the green peas could be insured as the correct type.
