## 11/30 FILING

**11/30 MN Crops/Programs:** APH/IP/RA Barley, APH Buckwheat, APH/RA Canola, APH/CRC/GRP/GRIP/RA Corn, APH Dry Beans, APH Dry Peas, APH Flax, Dollar Forage Seeding, APH Green Peas, YBD Hybrid Corn Seed, APH Oats, APH Popcorn, APH Potatoes, APH Processing Beans, APH/CRC/GRP/GRIP/RA Soybeans, APH Sugar Beets, APH/RA Sunflowers, APH Sweet Corn, APH/CRC/GRP/GRIP/IP/RA Wheat

### COUNTY CROP EXPANSION:

- BUCKWHEAT: Added to Beltrami, Freeborn, Hubbard, East Otter Tail, West Otter Tail, Pope, Todd, and Wadena counties.

### COUNTY CROP DELETIONS:

- GRP/GRIP CORN deleted in Becker, Clay, Crow Wing, Mahnomen, Norman, East Otter Tail, West Otter Tail, East Polk, West Polk, Wadena, and Wilkin counties.
- GRP/GRIP SOYBEANS deleted in Becker, Clay, Mahnomen, Norman, East Otter Tail, West Otter Tail, East Polk, West Polk, and Wilkin counties.
- GRP/GRIP WHEAT deleted in Lake of the Woods and Traverse counties.

**DATES:** No changes

**RATES:** New target rates established for Corn, Dry Beans, Forage Seeding, Popcorn, and Sugar Beets.

### STATEMENTS:

- BARLEY:
  - Added Malting Barley statement to SPOIs in all counties with Malting Barley option that states 13.5% protein is the quality standard for two-rowed barley.
  - Added statements to SPOIs on how to insure new specialty types for RA and APH.
  - New pricing statements on SPOIs for RA.
- CORN:
  - Statement added to GRP SPOIs that revises the definition of “payment yield”.
  - Statement added to GRIP SPOIs that revises the definition of “final county yield”.
- POTATOES:
  - Quality statement clarifies the use of a default factor in cases where the producer has not supplied an actual average percentage.
  - Added statement: “Failure to provide actual average percentages will result in the use of default percentage below.”
- SOYBEANS:
  - Statements relating to insuring the new specialty types were added to the SPOIs for RA, CRC, and RA.
  - Statement added to GRP SPOIs that revises the definition of “payment yield”.
  - Statement added to GRIP SPOIs that revises the definition of “final county yield”.
- WHEAT:
  - Statement added to GRP SPOIs that revises the definition of “payment yield”.
  - Statement added to GRIP SPOIs that revises the definition of “final county yield”.
- Major changes to the quality adjustment statements on the SPOIs for all crops with quality provisions on the SPOIs.

### PRACTICES:

- DRY BEANS: Added practices (092) IBR-I and (093) IBR-NI to Chippewa and Stevens counties for new Black type.
- SUGAR BEETS: Changed practices from 997 to 002 and 003. Of the 33 beet counties, 27 will have only the non-irrigated practice and six counties will have both irrigated and non-irrigated.

### TYPES:

- BARLEY: New specialty types replace existing Spring (092) type for RA and APH.
- DRY BEANS: Added Black type (303) to Chippewa and Stevens counties.
- SOYBEANS: New specialty types replace the current 997 type for RA, CRC, and APH.

### T-YIELDS:

- T-Yields reviewed and updated for Corn, Dry Beans, Popcorn, and Sugar Beets.

- BARLEY specialty types have T-yield adjustments for RA and APH
- SOYBEAN specialty types have T-yield adjustments for RA, CRC and APH.

**MAPS:** Changes made to map boundaries for Roseau County.

**SUPPLEMENTS:** Changes made to Goodhue County.
