<u>11/30 WI Crops/Programs</u>: Combo Barley, APH Cabbage, APH Cigar Binder Tobacco, Combo/ARPI/AYP Corn, APH Cucumbers, APH Dry Beans, Dollar Forage Seeding, Combo Grain Sorghum, APH Green Peas, YBD Hybrid Corn Seed, APH Oats, ARPI/AYP Popcorn, APH Potatoes, APH Processing Beans, Combo/ARPI/AYP Soybeans, APH Sweet Corn

COUNTY CROP EXPANSION: CUCUMBERS: Pickling type intended for processing in Adams, Green Lake, Juneau, Marquette, Portage, Waupaca, Waushara, and Wood Counties.

COUNTY CROP DELETIONS: None.

DATES: No changes.

RATES:

- Rate reviews completed with new target rates established for Barley, Corn (grain & silage), Forage Seeding, Grain Sorghum, Green Peas, Hybrid Corn Seed, Popcorn, and Sweet Corn.
- Some rates for other crops may have changed due to rates moving toward previously established target rates.

STATEMENTS:

- Added SPOI "General" statement setting prevented planting coverage as a percentages of the production guarantee for timely planted acreage. The percentage varies by crop.
- Removed SPOI statement regarding interest accrual on premium amounts or fees owed FCIC.
- Removed SPOI "Practice" statement on separating certified organic and transitional acreage APH databases.
- Area Plans (ARP & AYP) Modified the conservation compliance statement regarding producers who started farming after June 1 but prior to July 1 (beginning of reinsurance year) may be eligible for the premium subsidy without having form AD-1026 on file with FSA on or before June 1.
- Combo Plans (YP, RP, RP-HPE) Removed SPOI statements for all counties on conservation compliance requirements to file an AD-1026 with FSA.
- Added text to Section C that expands discount factors for aflatoxin to include "mycotoxins and other" for the edible portion of crops exposed to flood waters.

TYPES/PRACTICES:

• DRY BEANS: planted row spacing is not a factor used to determine practice. IBR/NIBR practices were changed to irrigated (002)/non-irrigated (003).

T-YIELDS:

• T-yield reviews completed for Barley, Corn (grain & silage), Grain Sorghum, Green Peas, Hybrid Corn Seed, Popcorn, and Sweet Corn.

MAPS: No changes.
