Crop Insurance Deadline Nears in Virginia

RALEIGH, N.C., Oct. 30, 2014 — USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) reminds Virginia clam producers that the final date to apply for crop insurance on next year's crop is November 30, 2014. Current policyholders who wish to make changes to their existing policies also have until November 30 to do so. Clam insurance is currently available under a pilot program in Accomack and Northampton Counties.

The amount of coverage is based upon an inventory value of your clam beds with a price election of \$.15 per clam. Crop insurance provides effective protection against death of clams due to oxygen depletion, disease, freeze, hurricane, decrease of salinity, tidal wave, storm surge and ice floe.

Producers should contact a local crop insurance agent for premium quotes and other details. For more information, producers are encouraged to visit the RMA website at <u>www.rma.usda.gov</u>, or to contact their local crop insurance agent as soon as possible.
