SUBJECT: Fumonisin in Corn – Salvage Markets

## **BACKGROUND**

Weather conditions this year have resulted in diverse quality issues in corn from no damage to not being accepted by elevators. One of the specific issues is Fumonisin. Differing levels of Fumonisin may result in either a discount in price or the requirement to destroy the corn altogether.

## **ACTION**

Approved Insurance Providers (AIP) have requested a list of potential salvage markets for corn. Below is a list of corn buyers with Fumonisin. This list is not complete and is provided as a guide to assist the AIP in locating salvage markets.
