SUBJECT: Status Update on Agricultural Risk Protection Act (ARPA) Implementation -

Section 121 - Compliance and Program Integrity

As you know, the Risk Management Agency (RMA) is charged with implementing Section 121 of the Agricultural Risk Protection Act (ARPA). RMA has been working closely with the Farm Service Agency (FSA) on five implementation teams. Each team is implementing a section of the legislation. The two agencies developed a Coordinated Plan for Implementation signed by the Secretary on January 12 as required by ARPA and presented to the crop insurance industry on January 18. The teams focused their work on developing internal communications and procedures for the two agencies to work together at the field level. In recent weeks the ARPA teams have been expanded to include company participants.

To assist in bringing all interested parties up to date on the work of these five teams, the following status update is provided. Information previously requested by the industry is included such as the list of all company participants and the dates, location and purpose of all upcoming meetings.

Please note that a March 1 meeting is planned to bring together all new company participants and team leaders in Kansas City. The exact times and location will be provided to the company participants by the team leaders.

## **Referrals Team**

**Team Objective**: Implement the following legislative requirement:

AT THE REQUEST of the Corporation or, subject to paragraph (2), on its own initiative if the Farm Service Agency has reason to suspect the existence of program fraud, waste, or abuse, conducting fact finding relative to allegations of program fraud, waste, or abuse;

REPORTING TO THE CORPORATION, in writing in a timely manner, the results of any fact finding conducted pursuant to subparagraph (A), any allegation of fraud, waste, or abuse, and any identified program vulnerabilities; and

FSA INQUIRY- If, within five calendar days after receiving a report submitted under paragraph (1)(B), the Corporation does not provide a written response that describes the intended actions of the Corporation, the Farm Service Agency may conduct its own inquiry into the alleged program fraud, waste, or abuse on approval from the State director of the Farm Service Agency of the State in which the alleged fraud, waste, or abuse occurred. If as a result of the inquiry, the Farm Service Agency concludes further investigation is warranted, but the Corporation declines to proceed with the investigation, the Farm Service Agency may refer the matter to the Inspector General of the Department of Agriculture.
