SUBJECT: Regional Irrigation Assessments

BACKGROUND:

The Loss Adjustment Manual (LAM), FCIC 25010, requires the Risk Management Agency (RMA) Regional Offices (RO) to issue Regional Irrigation Assessments to identify areas which are suspected of having inadequate irrigation water supplies. The attached irrigation assessments are provided:

- Cameron, Hidalgo, Willacy and Starr counties, Texas - Oklahoma City RO,
- Republic County, Kansas and selected counties, Nebraska - Topeka RO,
- All counties, Montana - Billings RO,
- Selected counties Idaho, Oregon and Washington - Spokane RO,
- Pinal County, Arizona, selected counties, California - Davis RO, and
- Selected counties, Florida - Valdosta RO.

This is not a determination of the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation that adequate irrigation water supplies are or are not available in the respective areas. To continue the proper administration of the irrigated practice for insured crops, insurance providers are directed to the LAM, Section 6, PAR 40 and the review requirements in Manual 14, Guidelines and Expectations for Delivery of the Federal Crop Insurance Program, FCIC 14010.
