SUBJECT: Regional Irrigation Assessment for Topeka Region

The Loss Adjustment Manual, FCIC-25010, directs the Regional Office (RO) to provide a regional assessment in order to identify areas and water districts where inadequate irrigation water supply is suspected. Following is the list of counties from the Topeka RO:

Kansas: The irrigation district of Kansas-Bostwick, located primarily in **Republic County**, has notified water right holders of an estimated 35 percent reduction from normal water allocations.

Nebraska: Frenchman Valley, H&RW, Frenchman-Cambridge and Nebraska-Bostwick irrigation districts have notified water right holders of reductions from normal water allocations. These districts affect the counties of **Chase, Dundy, Franklin, Furnas, Harlan, Hayes, Hitchcock, Nuckolls, Red Willow, and Webster.** The Mirage Flats irrigation district that provides water to a portion of **Sheridan** county will also receive a reduced allocation. (Nebraska information received from the U. S. Bureau of Reclamation.)

The insured crops grown in the areas identified as having a suspected lack of irrigation water are corn, grain sorghum, soybeans, and sunflowers. Corn and soybeans are the primary irrigated crops.
