SUBJECT: Contract Change Date Extension for the Pilot Adjusted Gross Revenue (AGR)  
Insurance Program

**BACKGROUND:**

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) is in the process of making improvements to the current AGR program for the 2001 insurance year to better meet the needs of producers. These changes have been requested by producers, agents, and reinsured companies and will be beneficial to policyholders. The contract change date is June 30, 2000, for the 2001 insurance year. However, to provide adequate time for policy development, an extension is necessary.

**ACTION:**

The contract change date for the Pilot Adjusted Gross Revenue Insurance Program for the 2001 crop year is extended to November 30, 2000. All reinsured companies must notify current policyholders of this contract change date extension in writing no later than June 30, 2000. RMA, upon approval, will make the AGR policy changes available no later than October 2, 2000, which is the scheduled actuarial document filing date for crops with a November 30, 2000, contract change date for the 2001 crop year.
