Cancellation of the Pilot Coverage Enhancement Option for all SUBJECT:

Applicable Crops Except Texas Citrus Trees

BACKGROUND:

The Pilot Coverage Enhancement Option (CEO) was implemented beginning with the 2000 crop year for Apples and Grapes in Pennsylvania and Washington; Canola in North Dakota; Citrus Trees in Texas; Cranberries in Massachusetts; Potatoes in Idaho, Maine, and Pennsylvania; Rice in Arkansas, Louisiana, and Mississippi; Stone Fruit in California; and Walnuts in California, and for the 2001 crop year for Citrus Fruit in Florida and Texas. The pilot program was evaluated by an independent contractor and the results of the evaluation were presented to the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors (Board) on July 29, 2004. Based on the results of the evaluation, the Board decided to terminate CEO for all crops except Texas Citrus Trees, which will continue as a pilot program through the 2008 crop year.

ACTION:

Effective for the stated crop year CEO will no longer be available for the following States and crops:
