SUBJECT: Legislative Authority to Continue the Following Crops for the 2001 Crop Year

BACKGROUND:

During the recent September 15, 1999, meeting between the Risk Management Agency (RMA) and insurance providers, it was requested that a list be provided of crop programs expiring due to the lack of legislative authority. The Federal Crop Insurance Act as amended through June 23, 1998, provides for revenue insurance pilot programs through the 2000 crop year. Without legislative authority to continue revenue programs, the following crops will be discontinued and policies canceled for the 2001 crop year.

CROP STATES

Avocado California - Cancellation date is November 30, 1999.

Dollar Citrus California - New Program that cannot be issued. Sales Closing

Date is November 20, 1999.

Pecans Georgia, Texas, New Mexico

Two year policy (may be sold during the 2000 crop year sales

period only.)
