Changes to the RA program include increasing the maximum coverage level for enterprise and whole-farm units to 85 percent and allowing written agreements for land risks only. In addition, the RA program was expanded into Idaho and Indiana, and canola/rapeseed, feed barley, and sunflower were approved as new crops. RA coverage will be available for the following States and crops: (1) Idaho - canola/rapeseed, feed barley, and spring wheat; (2) Illinois - corn and soybean; (3) Indiana - corn and soybean; (4) Iowa - corn and soybean; (5) Minnesota - corn,

soybean, and spring wheat; (6) North Dakota - canola/rapeseed, corn, feed barley, soybean, spring wheat, and sunflower; (7) South Dakota - corn, soybean, and spring wheat.
