SUBJECT: Actuarial Addendum - Missing Information on 2000 Crop Year Crop Revenue

Coverage (CRC) and Revenue Assurance (RA) Actuarial Documents

BACKGROUND:

The CRC enterprise unit option factor table is missing from the Actuarial Documents in the following expansion States for the 2000 crop year:

Corn: CT, DE, ME, MA, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, VT, WV

Soybeans: DE, NJ, NY, WV

Grain Sorghum: FL, MD

Also, RA high risk factors and some high risk map areas were incomplete on Actuarial Documents.

ACTION:

The Actuarial Data Master has been corrected and will be regenerated to reflect these changes.

The CRC Actuarial Documents will be regenerated and made available on the Risk Management Agency (RMA) website as well as the Reporting Organization Server. Any interested party can view and print directly from the RMA website as necessary, at http://www.act.fcic.usda.gov/tools/actdoc.

The RA Actuarial Documents will not be regenerated since high risk factors and high risk map areas are identical for actual production history (APH) and RA plans of insurance. Please refer to the APH (insurance Plan 90) Actuarial Documents. These are also available on the RMA website.
