SUBJECT: 2000 Support Prices for Guaranteed Tobacco and Quota Tobacco Crop Provisions

The 2000 price support levels as defined in the Guaranteed Tobacco Crop Provisions 99-071 for the purposes written in Section 12(c)(1)(iii)(A) and in Section 12(d)(3) are listed below:

37	233 VA Sun-Cured Tobacco	\$1.38
54-55	235 Cigar Binder Tobacco	\$1.24

The 2000 support price for type 31 tobacco (crop code 231-quota burley) as defined in the Quota Tobacco Crop Provisions 99-070 for the purposes listed in Section 13(b)(1) and in Section 13(c)(1)(iii)(A) and 13(c)(1)(iii)(B) is \$1.81 per pound. The \$0.06 per pound warehouse fee is no longer deducted.
