SUBJECT: Implementation of Revised Rate Presentation Format to Accommodate
Continuous Rating for the 2001 Crop Year

The Risk Management Agency is implementing Continuous Rating for the 2001 crop year for all crops under RA (Plan 25), CRC (Plan 44), and APH (Plan 90). In addition to these, GYC (Plan 84) for both potatoes and sugar beets are being converted to Plan 90 and implemented under Continuous Rating for the 2001 crop year.

The rate presentation format of the County Actuarial Tables (FCI-35) are revised. Please refer to the documents listed below for information on specific Continuous Rating implementation issues.
