SUBJECT: Deletion of Selected County Crop Programs Effective for 2002 Crop Year

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) has expanded the availability of crop insurance programs dramatically over the past several years. Not all of the county programs, however, have succeeded.

A Risk Management Agency analysis revealed that several county crop programs had no or little sales in the 1999 and 2000 crop years. Those recommended for termination were then provided to the reinsured companies for review and comment. The resulting recommendations for termination were submitted and approved by the Board of Directors last November.

Effective for crop year 2002, the county crop programs on the attachment will no longer be available.
