- SUBJECT: Request for Input from Biomass Producer Groups and Trade Associations

BACKGROUND:

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) intends to obtain input from producer groups before entering into contracts for research and development to increase participation in areas or for commodities that may be underserved by the Federal crop insurance program. RMA believes this input is critical in determining the need and direction of research and potential development.

ACTION:

RMA requests input from groups or individuals representing producers of biomass generating crops so that their needs, concerns, and other input may be considered before it enters into a contract for the research and possible development of risk management strategies for producers who grow crops for biomass purposes. Of particular interest is any input that would help RMA determine producers= interest in such risk management strategies, as well as specific suggestions and concerns regarding the structure, scope, and limitations of such strategies.
