The 2002 price support levels as defined in the Guaranteed Tobacco Crop Provisions (99-071) for purposes written in Section 12(c)(iii)(A) and in Section 12(d)(3) are listed below:

37	233 VA Sun-Cured Tobacco	\$1.43
54-55	235 Cigar Binder Tobacco	\$1.29

The 2002 support price for type 31 tobacco (crop code 231-quota burley) as defined in the Quota Tobacco Crop Provisions (99-070) for purposes listed in Section 13(b)(1) and in Section 13(c)(iii)(A) and (B) is \$1.84 per pound. The \$0.06 per pound warehouse fee is no longer deducted.
