SUBJECT: Actuarial Addendum – 2004 Crop Year Wheat, Crop Revenue Coverage Plan  
Oregon and Washington Actuarial Documents

**BACKGROUND:**

The 2004 Crop Year Special Provisions of Insurance and FCI-35 Coverage and Rates for Crop Revenue Coverage (CRC) Plan 44 wheat documents for the seven counties listed below are missing a practice statement for the summer fallow (005) practice. This omission creates an unintended inequity for those desiring to insure under CRC versus the standard APH Plan 90 program as certain acreage would not be insurable under CRC, but would be insurable under APH Plan 90. The states and counties affected are:

Oregon – Umatilla  
Washington – Asotin, Columbia, Garfield, Spokane, Walla Walla, and Whitman

**ACTION:**

For the 2004 Crop Year, the following statement is applicable to type codes 011 Winter wheat and 012 Spring wheat for the summerfallow (005) practice insured under CRC Plan 44 in the counties designated above: **\*1 Includes wheat after peas, beans, alfalfa or clover**

Actuarial documents will not be “re-filed”; however, this Actuarial Addendum is supplemented to previously-filed documents and the Actuarial Data Master has been updated accordingly. The corrected documents may also be printed from the actuarial document browser found under Tools and Calculators on the RMA website at <http://www.rma.usda.gov>.

This Informational Memorandum is effective for the 2004 crop year and expires on December 31, 2004.
