	SUBJECT:	2005 Crop Year (CY) Additional Price Election for Durum Wheat in Arizona and California

The Risk Management Agency (RMA) today announced the additional price election for the 2005 CY for durum wheat in Arizona and California. The additional price represents the maximum price election for the crop year and is \$3.90 per bushel. This price election is available to all producers of durum wheat in Arizona and California who insure their 2005 crop at levels above catastrophic coverage. Price election choices must be made on or before the sales closing date for the crop in a county.

The price for catastrophic coverage is \$2.15 per bushel for durum wheat in Arizona and California.
