SUBJECT: Group Risk Income Protection-Harvest Revenue Option (GRIP-HRO) Expansion

to Grain Sorghum, for the 2005 Crop Year

On January 13, 2005, the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors approved GRIP-HRO for the 2005 crop year in all states and counties approved for GRIP grain sorghum. GRIP-HRO Grain Sorghum is available in certain states and counties that include 15 counties in south Texas having a January 31 sales closing date, 2 Texas counties with a February 15 sales closing date, and all other counties in Texas and all other states approved for GRIP and GRIP-HRO having a March 15 sales closing date.

Today, RMA also released all appropriate actuarial material reflecting the availability of GRIP-HRO for grain sorghum.
