

**SUMMARY OF CHANGES FOR THE COMMODITY EXCHANGE PRICE
PROVISIONS (CEPP): 2015 AND SUCCEEDING CROP YEARS**

(Revised CEPP documents released June 2014*, October 2014# and November 2014##)

1. **CEPP – Section II: Canola/Rapeseed*** – Modified tables for the August 31 and September 30 sales closing dates in order to reflect new coverage availability in Kentucky, South Carolina, Tennessee and Texas.
2. **CEPP - Section II: Wheat*** – Modified tables and text pertaining to Oregon in order to incorporate new price specifications for Klamath County, Oregon. The modifications align price specifications for Klamath County, Oregon with existing price specifications for California’s Intermountain Region Counties. The price specifications for all other counties in Oregon are unchanged.
3. **CEPP – Section II: Cotton#** - Modified table for the January 31 sales closing date in order to specify that the December contract will now be used instead of the October contract, which was used in previous years.
4. **CEPP – Section II: Grain Sorghum##** - Added text that provides definitions and specifications for distinct organic (certified) prices. Distinct grain sorghum organic practice prices are newly offered for the 2015 and succeeding crop years.

CEPP - Section I: General Information is NOT revised for the 2015 Crop Year.

CEPP - Section II documents for the following crops are NOT revised for the 2015 Crop Year: Barley, Corn, Rice, Soybeans and Sunflowers.
